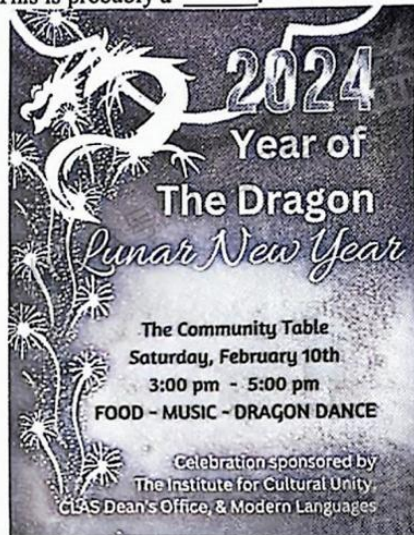

Children eagerly look for someone to imitate. That “someone” is usually one or both of their parents. Parents are a child’s first teacher. But more important, parents are a child’s first role model. A role model is someone who the child looks up to and wants to be like. Most parents continue to be a role model throughout the child’s life.

Usually, children are more affected by what their parents do, than by what they say. Children learn how to behave by seeing how their mothers and fathers behave and following that example.

That’s why the best way to help your children do their best at school is to show good study habits in your own life. If your children see you reading, they are more likely to read. If your children hear you thinking through problems, considering different solutions, they are more likely to think through their problems. If you meet deadlines and put in extra effort, so will your children. If you listen to others, so will your children. If you are curious, your children will be curious and enjoy learning. If you include the family in discussion, your children will learn how to express themselves.

Parents aren’t perfect. We lose our tempers and we have bad habits. Sometimes we do not set the perfect example. We are human and so are our children. What is important is that we admit to our mistakes, try to do better, and try to make up for our failures.

Being a good role model is one of the most important and rewarding things you can do for your children.

People may have different paths through education. While some go to college right after high school, others find their way back years later. This was the case for Minnie Payne.

The South Carolina native returned to the classroom after retiring at age 68, finally earning her bachelor's degree when she was 73. Instead of stopping there, Payne continued her higher education path at University of Northern Texas (UNT) and, 17 years later, became the oldest person to receive a master's degree at the school.

Although much older than the other students, she was eager to learn something new and reach her goal. "It's never too late to learn and Minnie Payne is making history," writes UNT. "As the oldest UNT graduate to complete her coursework, she has a passion for writing and a positive attitude, which has made college a joy rather than a task."

Payne had worked as a court reporter and a part-time teacher in a community in South Carolina. After retiring, she was admitted to Texas Women's University (TWU). A few years later, she graduated with a bachelor's degree in General Studies. Now at age 90, the self-described "lifelong learner" earned a master's degree in Interdisciplinary Studies.

Payne already has a new job lined up in Houston. She will be working at a magazine that is based in the area. "I don't want to stop work," she said. "I always want to improve myself and do something constructive." We wish Payne the best of luck in her new career.
